



BULK SUPPLY TARIFF

(FOR BULK SUPPLY OF DESALINATED WATER ON
DHO FAR WATER NETWORK)

APPLICABLE 1 JANUARY 2025 TO 31 DECEMBER
2025



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I. Introduction

Pursuant to Article 74 of the Sector Law (as defined below) and Condition 21 of the Power and Water Procurement Licence granted by the Authority for Public Services Regulation (**APSR**), Nama Power & Water Procurement Company (**PWP**) is required to make Bulk Supplies of Desalinated Water or Pre-COD Water Output to Nama Dhofar Services Company (**NDS**) in accordance with a Bulk Supply Agreement entered into for such purpose, and in consideration of a Bulk Supply Tariff.

PWP has entered into Bulk Supply Agreement with NDS, formerly the Directorate General of Water in the Governorate of Dhofar, covering *inter alia* the Bulk Supply of Desalinated Water or Pre-COD Water Output produced by the Plants (as defined below).

This document sets out the Bulk Supply Tariff, as determined by PWP and approved by APSR, in respect of Desalinated Water delivered or Pre-COD Water Output delivered to NDS from the respective plants for the period from 1 January 2025 to 31 December 2025.

It specifies (i) the fixed and variable charges payable by NDS and (ii) the arrangements for invoicing and payment.

Unless otherwise defined in this document, capitalised terms used in this document, and which are defined in the Bulk Supply Agreement shall have the meanings given to them therein. The following words and expressions, when used with capital initial letters, shall have the following meanings:

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“Bulk Supply” means the bulk supply of Desalinated Water or Pre-COD Water Output by PWP to NDS, and **“Bulk Supplies”** shall be construed accordingly.

“Bulk Supply Agreement” means an agreement entered between PWP and NDS in relation to the provision of Bulk Supplies of Desalinated Water.

“Bulk Supply Tariff” means the consideration charged by PWP for the Bulk Supply of Desalinated Water or Pre-COD Water Output, as determined from time to time by PWP and approved by APSR.

“Desalinated Water”	means, (i) in respect of the Salalah I IWPP, the Potable Water; and (ii) in respect of the Salalah III IWP, the Potable Water.
“Desalinated Water Delivered”	means the Desalinated Water delivered at the Potable Water Delivery Points by the Plants, which includes the Pre-COD Water Output, as measured by the Potable Water Metering Systems.
“Pre-COD Water Output”	means the Potable Water delivered at the Potable Water Delivery Points pursuant to dispatch instructions during any period before the commercial operation date as measured by the Potable Water Metering System.
“Plants”	means the following: (i) Salalah I IWPP; and (ii) Salalah III IWP, And “Plant” shall be construed as one of the above (as may be applicable).
“Potable Water”	means the water produced by the Plants which complies with Oman Standard Number 8/2012 (or such standard as may replace or amend this standard from time to time).
“Potable Water Delivered”	means the Potable Water delivered at the Potable Water Delivery Points by the Plant to NDS, in accordance with the dispatch instructions, as measured by the Potable Water Metering System.
“Potable Water Delivery Points”	means the connection points at the boundary fence between the Plant and NDS’s facilities where the Potable Water is delivered.
“Potable Water Metering System”	means the metering system utilised by NDS and the Plant owner to measure the quantities of Potable Water Delivered.
“Sector Law”	means the Law for the Regulation and Privatisation of the Electricity and Related Water Sector promulgated by Royal Decree No. 78/2004, as amended from time to time.
“Water Desalination Capacity”	means, (i) in respect of the Salalah I IWPP, the nominal capacity of the Plant to deliver Desalinated Water, being 68,190 m³/day from 1 January 2025 to 31 December 2025; and (ii) in respect of the Salalah III IWP, the nominal capacity of the Plant to deliver Desalinated Water, being 113,650 m³/day from 1 January 2025 to 31 December 2025.

2. Charges for Bulk Supply

The charges for Bulk Supply (see below), shall be payable on a monthly basis and shall comprise (i) a fixed charge, payable for the provision of the Water Desalination Capacity or Pre-COD Water Output; (ii) a variable charge payable in relation to the quantity of Desalinated Water Delivered or Pre-COD Water Output delivered to NDS, and differentiated in rate bands with respect to the time of day.

The fixed charge for Water Desalination Capacity or Pre-COD Water Output specified in Table 1 shall be payable in respect of the contracted capacity of each Plant or Pre-COD Water Output delivered by the Plant. In the event that the availability of the Water Desalination Capacity falls short of the contracted capacity, or the Pre-COD Water Output was not delivered by the Plant, the actual water availability cost will be adjusted, and over/under recovery will be captured by the correction factor (K-factor) for water. The K-factor shall be calculated by PWP and considered in the BST of the following year in accordance with a methodology approved by APSR.

2.1 Charges for Bulk Supply to NWS

(1) FIXED CHARGES

Table 1 shows the fixed charges applicable to Water Desalination Capacity provided or Pre-COD Water Output delivered provided to NDS.

(2) VARIABLE CHARGES

Variable charges applicable to Desalinated Water Delivered or Pre-COD Water Output delivered to NDS is shown in table 2 and 3 below.

Note: The approved BST is exclusive of the Value Added Tax (VAT), and as per the applicable rates, VAT will be charged over and above the bulk supply charges.

3. Invoicing and Payment

PWP shall invoice NWS for Bulk Supplies in accordance with the following procedure:

- (a) Immediately following the end of each month, PWP shall estimate the quantities of Bulk Supplies chargeable to NWS for that month using such reasonable method as it sees fit and shall issue a preliminary invoice based on such estimated quantities.

- (b) As soon as PWP receives the quantity of Desalinated Water Delivered or Pre-COD Water Output delivered each month, as certified by NWS and the relevant Plant owner, the variable charge rate specified in Tables 2 and 3 above shall be applied to the certified quantity of Desalinated Water Delivered or Pre-COD Water Output delivered each month. This shall be accompanied by a supplemental invoice or credit, as applicable, reflecting the adjustments required to the preliminary invoices.
- (c) PWP shall issue a full-year consolidated statement (if applicable), shortly following the end of the calendar year, together with a final reconciliation invoice (or credit note).

Payment of invoices issued as described above shall be made by NWS (as may be applicable) within thirty (30) days of receipt. Where a credit is issued to NWS as described above, the amount shall be settled by way of deduction from subsequent payment(s) of Bulk Supplies charges to PWP unless NWS requests, in writing, that the relevant amount be refunded in cash by PWP, in which case PWP shall make such payment within thirty (30) days of receipt of the written request.

4. Amendments

Under certain circumstances it may become necessary to amend this Bulk Supply Tariff during its period of application. Any such amendment shall only be made in accordance with PWP's Licence and with the approval of APSR. PWP shall provide NWS with details (including the date of application) of any amendment on a timely basis
